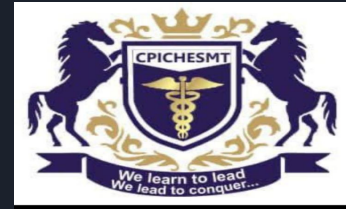

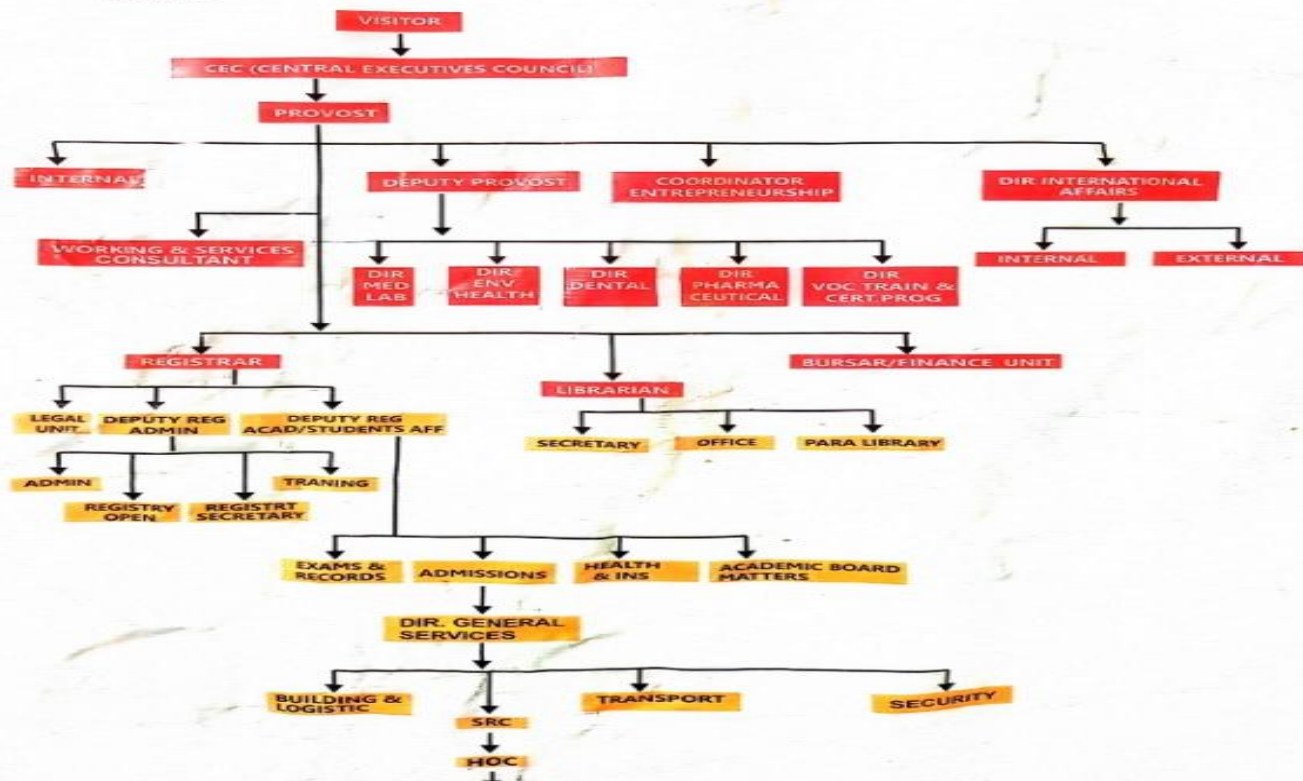




Organogram of the College
